For the past 45 years DOVE has been offering life-saving services to survivors of domestic and partner violence. The advocacy staff at DOVE work with intention to support survivors on their healing journey. Whether a survivor needs court advocacy, counseling, support groups, shelter, or children's services, DOVE is here to offer the necessary free and confidential support.

Unfortunately, the need for our services is ongoing and always urgent. This past year DOVE saw an increase in calls across all of our programs. In response, our advocates have worked tirelessly to eliminate the barriers our survivors face in order to receive the support necessary to move beyond violence. In addition to providing supports such as safety planning, rent assistance, and court representation, the staff have also created new ways to offer hope through healing.
